

2022 ANNUAL REPORT Bridge of Flowers

Shelburne Falls, Massachusetts

his was an eventful year for the Bridge of Flowers, as well as for our sponsoring institution, the Shelburne Falls Area Women's Club.

Among the most significant happenings for the Bridge committee was a state grant of \$2.46 million from MassWorks to the Shelburne Falls Fire District, which owns the Bridge. The grant will help to fund the Shelburne Falls Bridge Improvement Project, whose goal is to make both immediate and long-term repairs to the structure. The engineering firm of Tighe & Bond has been contracted to undertake the work, which will include addressing large stress cracks evident in some areas and stabilizing a key section of the north wall. A schedule for the project is expected to be announced this spring and may require partial or total closure of the Bridge for periods of time later this year or next. Announcements regarding closings will be made well in advance to alert both locals and visitors.

The Shelburne Falls Area Women's Club initiated discussions last year about restructuring both its administration and programming as it marked 97 years of service to the community. The Club is credited with transforming the old trolley bridge

into a blooming garden in 1929 and continues to support the Bridge of Flowers as a non-profit to this day.

According to Bridge guest books, well over 33,000 people visited April through October, 2022, but the actual number is likely closer to 100,000, since only approximately one-third of visitors actually sign in. Travelers from abroad were fewer than before the pandemic, but more came from distant states.

The gardens greeted visitors with a profusion of color despite an unusually dry season and the temporary absence of our head gardener, Carol DeLorenzo, who had sustained injuries to her shoulder and hand. During her recovery, we were fortunate to have Julie Petty, former chair of the Bridge of Flowers Committee, fill in for her.

Other new faces we welcomed last year included several more volunteers for the dedicated Blossom Brigade, whose members tend the gardens weekly during the growing season; and we were pleased to have Ann Lofquist join the Bridge of Flowers Committee. An established artist who recently moved to the area, Ms. Lofquist inspired us to begin planning a new venture, an art show and sale that we're calling "Art on the Bridge." Scheduled for October 14-15, 2023, it will feature local and regional artists whose work in 2D-media presents images of the Bridge to be exhibited and sold to benefit the Bridge. The newest face on the Bridge, however, was Assistant Gardener Elliston Bingham's baby girl, who arrived last spring.

The annual plant sale in mid-May attracted an enthusiastic crowd of plant lovers, whose purchases delighted them and furnished funds for Bridge maintenance. In late October, the Blossom Brigade energetically dug in hundreds of bulbs, promising a spectacular display of color for spring 2023.

As the year drew to a close, we looked back with gratitude for so much goodwill and good work accomplished, and began to look forward with many plans for 2023.
